GENESIS

The IMC, which was set up in 1907 has an active and vibrant Ladies' Wing which was established in 1966. Initiated as a forum for creating social awareness, it has progressed to become a dynamic association for the empowerment of women.

IMC-Ladies' Wing Jankidevi Bajaj Puraskar was instituted in 1993-the birth centenary of Smt. Jankidevi Bajaj (1893-1979), with an objective to seek a close alliance with rural India to promote, support and honour the substantial work being done in the field of entrepreneurship.

Smt. Jankidevi Bajaj, wife of Shri Jamnalal Bajaj, took to Gandhian way of life, propagated rural upliftment through cottage industries specially Khadi, actively participated in the freedom struggle and suffered imprisonment. She was known to be charitable and frugal, resolute yet compassionate, and was a self-made woman. She was the President of Akhil Bhartiya Goseva Sangh for many years since 1942. Smt. Bajaj received the Padma Vibhushan in the year 1956 for her exemplary work done for rural India.
